Dear Members of the Lynn Teachers Union: Hello!

Please take action and contact the members of the School Committee and the Mayor. During the Re-Opening Bargaining the City of Lynn was informing the Superintendent that the air quality assessments were being scheduled. The City did not obtain these assessments and never intended to do so. LPS will be obtaining the assessments, but that does not help inform our members about their safety, today.

The district states that we have been working in these buildings for years and at this time they have had zero onsite transmission of COVID19. Dr. Tutwiler has informed staff that ALL buildings are safe. They are relying on the GreenTech Environmental company representatives' word that their product will create a safe air quality in the buildings without mechanical air ventilation. This is without any testing of air quality prior to the installation.
